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Application and Registration Information

1. If possible, please indicate two seminars, a first and a second preference, either one of which your schedule would permit your attending.
2. If the Seminar of your first choice is already filled, you will immediately notified. If you wish, you may leave your application fee on deposit and a position will be reserved for you in the Seminar of your second choice. If not, your deposit will be returned forthwith.
3. Please note the registration deadline. The required \$100 deposit must reach the MDI office by this date.
4. You will be notified of formal MDI action on your application by mail. This will be accompanied by a receipt for your deposit.
5. Thirty-five dollars (\$35) of the deposit is a nonrefundable application processing fee. The remainder of the deposit is refundable only up until 10 days prior to the first day of the Seminar.
6. Full payment must be made by the date indicated. If it is not, space will be awarded to another applicant.
7. Some school teachers who have attended past seminars have received financial assistance from their school districts. Pursuit is the responsibility of the individual. Upon request, the Michigan Dyslexia Institute will provide the district with a description of the Seminar program, its staff, and a letter certifying successful completion of the Seminar.
